Principal's Message

It's November and it is an important month at Kleefeld School for several reasons. The first important event is our Remembrance Day assembly, which will occur on Thursday, November 10 @ 11:05. Our goal is to provide our students an opportunity to demonstrate their appreciation for the sacrifices others have made. We will have a special guest from Winnipeg Infantry Tactical Group representing our forces. Parents and community members are invited to join us.

The next important event happens on Friday, November 25 when Report Card #1 is emailed to parents or sent home with students. The purpose of the report card is to create a snapshot of each student as a learner at this point in the school year. Students are not compared to other students. Factors such as effort, behaviour and work habits are reported separately.

Teachers write comments to provide more detailed information about students' grades and learning behaviours. Teachers try to ensure that written comments are easy to understand. If we use terms that are unclear, please do not hesitate to ask for clarification. Each comment should describe student strengths, an area of learning that is challenging and the next steps to take to help students improve in the area of their challenge. For Gr. 1-6 students, comments on learning behaviours are at the end of the report card, while for Gr. 7 and 8, they are part of each subject.

Parent/Teacher interviews happen on Thursday, December 1. This is one of the most important evenings of the entire school year. All parents have time scheduled to meet with their children's teachers. Interview times are sent home with report cards. Please feel free to call us and adjust your interview times if they are not suitable to you. We want to meet with you and share our insights about your child as a learner. We want to hear the things you value, try to answer questions and hear concerns you might have. Our goal is to connect with you and work together with you to help your child be a successful learner. We invite you to partner with us, and we look forward to working with you.

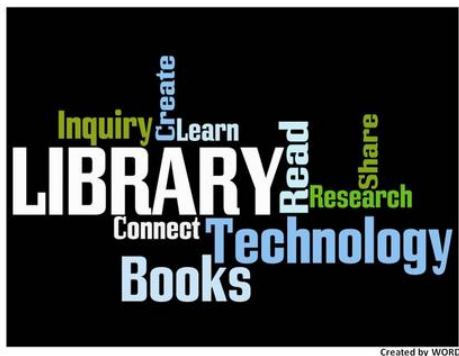
Band Booster News
