#### **TERM 2 REPORT CARDS AND PARENT/TEACHER INTERVIEWS**

Report card #2 will be send home on Friday, March 17. Parents can request to have the report card emailed rather than have a paper copy sent home.

The purpose of a report card is to provide parents with a picture or description of their child as a learner. Comments will accompany most subject marks.

The format of the comments should follow the outline of noting your student's **strengths**, then outlining a **challenge** your student is experiencing, followed by the **next step** which describes how the teacher will assist the student in working to improve the area of challenge.

Parent/Teacher Interviews happen on Thursday, March 23 from 4:30-6:30. This time, interviews are by parent request or teacher request. Parents, you are welcome to set up an appointment to connect with your student's teachers even if you have no particular concern.
