1. Fair Play Code of Conduct.

2. School performance as assessed by teachers.
 - a) Working to one’s capabilities in marks and homework
 - b) Cooperating in class and hallways\

3. Responsibilities as a representative of Kleefeld School
 - a) Showing proper behaviour and sportsmanship at all games
 - b) Giving respect that is due to the coach, supervisor, opponents, officials and fans

4. Attendance at school
 - a) Being in school on game day
 - b) Following the school attendance policy

5. Transportation
 - a) Showing proper etiquette on the bus or vehicle used
 - b) Abiding by all transportation arrangements made by the coach

6. Injury Notification
 - a) If a student has sustained an injury, such as a concussion, in a sport played outside of school hours, it is important that the Phys. Ed. Department be made aware of the situation through a note or a phone call.
