HSD PARENT PORTAL

Last year, the use of the HSD Parent Portal was introduced to Kleefeld School parents. The goal of the Parent Portal is to provide enhanced and increased communication. Permission for field trips, sending and receiving notifications and paying school fees can all be done through the portal.

In order to set up a Parent Access Account, a unique Access ID is required. This, along with account setup instructions was sent to all parents/guardians via email. If you did not receive the email - No Problem! If you have tried to set up the Access Account and are experiencing difficulties - No Problem! In both cases, please stop by the school office and either Mrs. Sawatzky or Mrs. Dueck, our school secretary will be happy to help set the accounts up.



HEAD LICE SEASON WILL BE ARRIVING SOON!

The season that head lice become active and mobile will soon be upon us. **The most important thing for parents to hear is that when your child has head lice, it is in no way a personal reflection on them or their family.** They are just very mobile little creatures.

Parents, please check your children for lice and treat accordingly. If advice or supplies are needed, please contact the school—we are happy to help.

If it is possible to notify the school, we greatly appreciate it. We will send letters home to students in the class and take necessary precautions to limit the spread of the lice. **THE CHILD(REN) WITH LICE WILL REMAIN ANONYMOUS!**

The most important way to get rid of head lice is to ensure that all nits and eggs are removed from every strand of hair on the person's head. There are special combs for to do this.



RELIGIOUS EXERCISES AND INSTRUCTION

The HSD Board of Trustees has received petitions requesting that religious exercises be held in Kleefeld School. Parents must indicate their students participation each year. Students can be added or removed from participation at any time with a signed note from parents.
