# Peligious Exercises and Instruction

The HSD Board of Trustees

has received petitions for and has granted permission for Religious Exercises and Religious Instruction for the 2019-2020 school year. Parents <u>must give</u> <u>permission for their students participation each year</u>, therefore, permission is needed for the 2019-2020 school year. Forms are available in the office by request, or parents/guardians can write a note indicating permission. Hanover School Division provides religious exercises and instruction in line with provincial quidelines.

#### Student Fees

With the start of the school year comes some student fees. We try hard to keep these to a minimum for families. In an effort to make payments as easy as possible, access to the Parent Portal can be set up. Your students fees are added together with the total listed there. Funds can be contributed any time that is convenient. Fees which are included are:

- Gr 1-8 activity fee (\$5)
- Gr 7/8 Tech Ed/Home Ec fee (\$15)
- Gr 7/8 Band Instrument Rental fee (\$150)

Hot lunch and milk orders can be added, along with sports team uniform costs and field trip fees. Questions can be answered by calling the school office.






## Bus Loop & Drop Off Info

We are working hard to ensure the safety of all students as they travel to and from school. Here are some ways you can help: When dropping students off...

- 1) On Friesen Ave, new lines have been painted to remind drivers to <u>leave space between your vehicle and the curb</u> so there is room to walk.
- 2) Please do not pull into the drop off lane on Friesen Ave. against the flow of traffic (facing the wrong way). Drivers may be ticketed.
- 3) Reduce speed to 30 KM/HR in the marked school zone.
- 4) Please do not drop off students in the parking lot. We cannot see your kids.
- 5) <u>Use the bus loop</u> for drop offs and pick-ups after the busses have departed.
