Thank you for registering your students for their visit to KS next week. Here is what you need to know for that visit.

- 1) Screening - Please ensure that all students coming to school have no fever, cough, sore throat or shortness of breath. Staff will screen students as they arrive @ KS
- 2) What to Bring - Students should bring a filled water bottle (there is no access to water fountains at this time)
 - Students can bring their own snack and writing supplies
- 3) Arrival
 - Students can come to school by bike, walking or having a parent drive them. Last names A-K please drop off at 9:20, last names L-Z at 9:30. Those with afternoon appointments come in at 1:00.
 - If it is not raining - students should be dropped off along Friesen Ave to be organized in the bus loop.
 - If it is raining - students will be asked to enter through the parking lot door and make their way into the gym to be organized there.
- 4) Social Distancing Protocols - One of the important goals of this visit to school is to teach students how to practice social distancing at school. We will work to teach them how to do this in an atmosphere that is welcoming and reassuring.
- 5) Cleaning - Mr Roy is following rigorous cleaning protocols.
 - Frequently touched surfaces are being cleaned repeatedly throughout the day
 - Additional staff have been hired to thoroughly clean the school each evening
