## Kleefeld School Growing

- New families moving in, kids coming back from Distance learning
- With the growing classes a new grades ¾ overflow classroom in the Computer Lab was formed, rotation every 1.5-2 weeks
- o Kleefeld school has room options if older grades grow in the future

#### - School Year 2021-2022

- Looking at staffing for next year
- Hanover is planning September as if Covid is done! (that's the hope, see what happens moving forward)
- o 70 homeschool kids that have the opportunity to come back if they so choose
- o Look at total number of staff we have, number of students per grade
- o Possibility of a few more split classrooms next year, nothing decided as of yet
- **Tech meeting** looking at buying some upgrades, projectors, better technology, etc.
- Hot lunches; Inquiry from an outside group
  - Hanover School Division not at that point yet to allow outside groups to come into the School
- After School Activities- looking at what could be available
  - Decisions come from Hanover School Division, so all schools have similar opportunity

- How has Kindergarten Registration gone so far?
  - o Good turn out!
  - All digital this year
- How are Kindergarten classes decided? What's taken into consideration?
  - Bussing, North and South of Kleefeld (not our decision)
  - Look at neighbourhoods kids for walkers
  - Try and have even class sizes
- Do we know if we will be staying in code orange after Spring Break?
  - We don't know that, dictated by the Province, the Government tells the school division and we go from there
- What would be best for the teachers/students/school in regard to the levels?
  - Code Yellow, would go down to 1m spacing, get rid of overflow classrooms, they can all be with their homeroom teachers
- SayZoons- suggested as a fun outdoor Recreational activity
  - At this point Hanover is saying no to visitors coming onto the school yard, but a good option to keep in mind for future
- How did the Book Fair do?
  - o Not near as it has in the past, but Mrs. Kroeker was very happy considering the year
    - \$500-\$600 versus normally \$6000 or so
- *Music Class* sometimes they are wearing a mask in grade 1, sometimes they're not. Grade 3's don't wear a mask. Are they supposed to?
  - o They shouldn't have to in K-3, Mr.Bergen will look into this matter
