Grade 7 and 8

1. Each school rep should contact the other school rep prior to game to confirm approx numbers and evening format.
2. Covid-19 protocols followed per VBM RTP with HSD specific rules and guidelines.
3. Stay on your own side and on own bench for the full match including warmups
4. Warm Up - stay on your side of the court. Opposing team shags balls for serving and hitting
5. Coin toss will be for service only.
6. Players and coaches on the bench must be masked at all times.

7. All players must wear masks between sets.
8. One game ball can be used for each match. Should be wiped between sets and/or rotated in with a clean ball after each set.
9. End of match - Teams will line up on baseline at end of match. Referee will signal to go to 3m line. Teams acknowledge the team and official.

Game play

1. Score will be kept, games to 25, no cap
2. One Timeout per set
3. Equal playing time
4. No need to send scores
5. Touch on the net rule interpretation: we will continue to allow incidental contact on the net that does not affect the result of a rally (anyway)
