PINK SHIRT LESSONS

Each classroom will be given grade-specific lessons for Pink Shirt Day (physical copy in your mailbox and digital copy sent to you via Joslyn). This is your choice on if and how to carry out the lessons :)

Activity 1: *KINDNESS IS...*

Each classroom will get small Pink Shirt templates. We will ask the students, "What does being kind look like to you?" Each student is asked to write a message on the shirt starting with: Being kind looks like.... We will add these messages to the main hallway to help students understand what it means to be kind at all grade levels.

Activity 2: *IN YOUR FACE!*

Student council members will be set up in the main hallway, ready to add a message of support for Pink Shirt Day. They will be available to draw this year's motto, "BE KIND," along with a heart or a smiley face on either student's cheeks or the back of their hands.

Activity 3: *PINK SHIRT DAY*

Show your support for Pink Shirt Day by wearing a pink shirt. Anyone who makes the effort to wear a pink shirt to school (not just a small symbol or splash of pink) will secretly have their name entered by their homeroom teacher for a prize draw to be revealed on Thursday. The Prizes will be divided into K - 3, 4 - 6, 7 - 8

Teachers can simply check off students on a class list, and we can then submit them to a randomizer to select the winner.
